Guidelines

- Applicants must be a member of The Columbus (OH) NAACP or youth council for at least 30 days before the 2007 Back To School/Stay in School (BTS/SIS) August 25, 2007.
- The applicant has to participate in the local branch or youth council in some capacity – such as volunteer at the (BTS/SIS) or at past events. Their involvement must be at this local branch or youth council, not the state or any other local branches or youth councils.
- The applicant must complete the application and submit a 1-pg essay on how they have persevered to either go "back to school"-get a diploma/GED and are now enrolled in college or they have "stayed in school" and now are in college or enrolled to attend college.
- The applicant must submit either a copy of their last terms grades (to show that they are enrolled in a college or university); an acceptance letter; or transcripts (non official copy).
